

ECB Yorkshire South Premier League



Club of the Year award criteria

The winner is to be determined by according to the criteria below. Where rankings are generated, the top club will be awarded 12 points; the bottom club will be awarded one point. Where clubs are equal in a ranking, the average points appropriate to the respective positions will be awarded, rounded up to the next whole number. The club with the most points overall wins the award.

The criteria and rankings for each criterion are:

Administration	Clubs ranked according to compliance with player registration, reporting and scoring procedures
All Stars	Clubs ranked according to percentage new entrant increase/decrease on 2018 numbers*°
Changing facilities	Clubs ranked according to marks awarded for this criteria on after-match reports
Fair play	Clubs ranked using fair play marks and disciplinary points
Ground & facilities	Clubs ranked according to number of YSPL ground & facilities criteria met
Hosting junior representative games	Clubs to be ranked according to whether their ground is made available for junior representative cricket games
Playing area	Clubs ranked according to ground markings
Playing success	Clubs ranked according to league and t20 success with 12 points awarded to the League champions and one point to the bottom club and two points added for t20 group winners, four t20 finalists, and six for t20 champions
Safeguarding	Clubs ranked according to number of club officials who have had up-to-date Safe Hands training – six points will be deducted where a safeguarding incident has occurred that has not been satisfactorily dealt with
Social media accounts	Clubs ranked according to positive activity, including promotion of: ECB/YCB initiatives and priorities; YSPL activities & events; sponsors*
Teas	Clubs ranked according to marks awarded for this criteria on after-match reports
Under 19 t20	6 points awarded for clubs entering a team in the YSPL competition; nine points for finalists and 12 points for winners
Womens' softball	Six points each for running a team and for hosting a softball event°
Youth teams	12 points awarded for running three teams, eight for two, and four for one°

* judging of this criteria to be undertaken in conjunction with YCB
