General. The YSPL competition will constitute an initial group stage of games that will be played on a league basis, followed by a knock-out stage that culminates in a finals day. Clubs may be seeded to determine the stage at which they enter the competition. The winner on finals day will go forward to the Yorkshire finals of the competition.

Entry. Entry shall be optional for all clubs who are members of the YSPL and the SYSCL Championship. Clubs may join together to enter joint teams.

Fixtures. The schedule, draw and venues for the competition will be published on the YSPL website.

Balls. Pink balls will be used throughout the competition. These will be provided by the YCB.

Clothing. Coloured clothing shall be worn by all clubs throughout the competition. For clarification, equipment such as pads and batting gloves are not required to be colour co-ordinated.

Eligibility of Players. Players must be aged under 19 at midnight on 31st August in the year prior to the relevant season. A player may only play for one club during the competition in any given season. Guest players will be allowed. Overseas players that have not been normally resident in the UK for a minimum of 18 months are not eligible to play in this competition. Any questions on eligibility should be addressed to the competition secretary before the semi-final or final.

Disputes. Any dispute must be referred to the competition organiser, who will investigate and, where necessary, refer to the League management committee for a decision. The committees' decision will be final and binding.

Rules. Except as provided for above, the competition will be played in accordance with the ECB club t20 rules.
