



## Weekly bulletin – 10 August 2019

On a day when only one of the six games failed to beat the poor weather, leaders Doncaster lost for the third league game running – this time by a single run in a thrilling finish at Elsecar, where, with plenty of overs in hand, the visitors' last man was run out attempting a run that would have tied the scores. Matt Higgins (55) was the match-winner for Elsecar in a game in which only one other batsman reached 30.

Barnsley missed the chance to close the gap on the leaders to just ten points, when they were beaten by Hallam at Shaw Lane. Chasing 181 to win, the home side fell 19 short despite Jon Trower's 44; Jim Tasker bowling the visitors to a fourth successive win. Sheffield Collegiate's four points for their cancelled game against Tickhill at Abbeydale drew them level on points with the Griffins.

Wins for Treeton and Wakefield Thornes over relegation-threatened Cleethorpes and bottom club Aston Hall respectively, mean that there are just four points separating the clubs in second to fifth places. A seventh-wicket stand of 71 between Treeton's Haseeb-Ur-Rahman and Ben Birtles was decisive at Chichester Road, where the visitors recorded a 34-run win despite the all-round efforts of Alex Osmond. At Field Lane, a free-scoring performance by the home side in a truncated innings meant that Aston Hall faced a daunting DLS target of 234 in 41 overs, and despite some late hitting, they fell well short.

An unbroken stand of 111 for the third wicket by MCC colleagues James Moorhouse and Neil Longhurst saw Whitley Hall record a comfortable eight-wicket win over Wickersley in a 40-over game that keeps the visitors just ten points above the relegation places.
